

Requirements for divorce registration in Lebanon through this Consulate-General

Lebanese who divorced in NSW, can register their divorce via diplomatic correspondence of the necessary documentation with the proper authorities in Lebanon. To qualify, applicants should provide the following:

- Download and complete Form A1 - Insure your consular file number is clearly stated.
- Divorcees marriage certificate issued at the Lebanese Registry Office and authenticated by the Lebanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Emigrants (Certificate plus 2 photocopies).
- Family Extract of registration, issued at the Lebanese Registry Office and authenticated by the Lebanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Emigrants (original plus 2 Photocopies)
- **Original, absolute and final** Divorce Order or Decree Nisi, issued by **the same** spiritual or Civil authorities which had solemnized the divorcees original marriage, translated to Arabic and **both documents (certificate and its translation)** are authenticated by the Sydney office of the Department of the Foreign Affairs & Trade, located on Level 7-26 Lee Street, Sydney Ph. 02-9207 6904 (originals plus one copy)
- **Applicants must appoint someone in Lebanon to execute the Divorce Order at the Court of Appeal in Beirut.**

N.B. Applicants requesting Consular registration certificates have to submit self-addressed envelopes bearing appropriate postal stamps for later posting.
