Occurring in the State of New South Wales

Deaths of Lebanese occurring in NSW, can be registered via diplomatic correspondence with the relative authorities in Lebanon. Applicants should provide the following:

Form A1

- Go to site: http://www.lebconsyd.org.au/index2.htm, click "Consular Services", Click "Forms", Click "A1 (Civil Status & passport Application Forms)", Print and complete, ensure your consular file number is clearly stated.

Lebanese identification documents of the deceased

- The deceased individual Lebanese identification documents (new or old)
 - AND a Family Extract of civil status records بيان قيد عائلي issued by the deceased relative census office in Lebanon, clearly showing the deceased family members whose death registration has already been established in Lebanon.

Lebanese passport of the deceased

- The Lebanese passport of the deceased should be turned over with the registration documents in order to **be made void**.

Full extract of the local Death Certificate

- Original full extract of the death certificate (to be retained by this Consulate-General), issued by the NSW Registry Office located at:35 Regent Street, Chippendale (ph. 1300 655 236), <u>AND</u> certified by the Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade located on: 26 Lee Street, Sydney.

Applicants requesting Consular registration certificates have to submit self-addressed envelopes bearing the appropriate postal stamps for later postage.
