

Documents required for marriage registration

Solemnised in the State of New South Wales

Marriages in NSW subject to registration in Lebanon can be registered via diplomatic correspondence with the relative Lebanese authorities. Applicants should provide the following:

Form A1

- Go to site: <http://www.lebconsyd.org.au/index2.htm>, click "Consular Services", Click "Forms", Click "A1 (Civil Status & passport Application Forms)", Print and complete, ensure your consular file number is clearly stated.

Lebanese identification documents

- Applicants' individual Lebanese identification documents (**new or old**, original plus 2 Photocopies).
 - **OR** – Applicants' individual or Family extract of civil status records بيان قيد إفرادي أو عائلي (**new or old**, originals plus 2 photocopies) issued by the applicants' relative census office in Lebanon.

Full extract of marriage certificate

- Original full extract of the marriage certificate with One Photocopy. The photocopy of the certificate is retained by the Consulate-General and the original is returned to the applicant after the verification of its content. Certificates are issued by the NSW Registry Office located at:

- **If one of the spouses is non-Lebanese:**
 1. Current passport plus 2 photocopies.
 2. Birth certificate with One Photocopy. The photocopy of the certificate is retained by the Consulate-General and the original is returned to the applicant after the verification of its content.
 3. Registration Application forms should be completed in Arabic and English

Applicants requesting Consular registration certificates are to submit self-addressed envelopes bearing the appropriate postal stamps for later postage.
